#### **Basketball & Tennis**

Lisa Regan told the Commissioners that the basketball camp at Niantic Park is a great program. She is willing to help with fund raising money to improve the court.

Commissioners informed her that the money requested from CPC to rehabilitate the courts was not approved as it does not meet the criteria currently in place. They are waiting to hear about legislature changes that would allow such projects.

Ms Regan said she would like to use the tennis courts during the shoulder season but it was locked.

Commissioner Combra suggested selling keys to Oak Bluffs residents for the off season from October 15 to May 15 and then change the lock during the summer.

#### **Landscape invoices**

Commissioner Combra said the work was done and was part of the contract that was signed by a previous Commissioner. He said part would be paid from Park budget and the revolving fund.

Commissioner Billings agreed and both signed off on the payment vouchers.
