Public Input

Triathlon

Commissioners reviewed applications to use Ocean Park for finish line and Waban/Alley Park for registration and post-race events. There was discussion of the logistics of where the event is supposed to be held as plans have changed since original applications.

Commissioner Combra stated that the open market is still allowed to use Waban/Alley Park on Sunday, September 11th. He said he will arrange a meeting with organizer in early September.

Parking issues

Discussion of parking during Open Market; Gail Barmakian was concerned about vehicles parking in front of the houses along Nantucket Avenue. Ms Cowley said that they will put up more signs indicating where people should park.

Commissioner Billings felt that the Police Department was not enforcing parking regulations diligently as vehicles were left in both Sunset Lake Park & Waban/Alley Park after the Illumination and fireworks.

Waban/Alley Park

Ms Barmakian asked about the petition to remove "rain garden" and restore area to grass. She said she had spoken with Chairman of the Conservation Commission who had no objections to its removal.

Commissioner Billings said she would like to see the plants be reused somewhere else.

Commissioner Combra would like to have something in writing from the Conservation Commission allowing its removal.
