Funding Required

Water Testing:

For coliform (8 sites); sources of bacteria (DNA tests, 4 sites); water chemistry – salinity, temperature, dissolved oxygen, nutrients, chloroform A, total suspended particulates, etc.; have monitoring plan, testing schedule, sampling protocol

\$22,560 (annual)

Field Observation:

To survey entire Sengekontacket waterfront for pollutants; train volunteers

\$1,500

Pet Waste Stations:

To be set up at State Beach, Edgartown Landing of the Boulevard and Pecoy Point

\$800

Dredging:

Little Bridge Inlet - annual maintenance

Channel between two bridges – permitting in progress

By Bend in the Road

Crab Creek/Cow Bay (private funding)

\$10,000 Little Bridge (annual)

Estimate = \$350,000

Estimate = \$150,000

Massachusetts Estuaries Project: This committee to be named the official MEP town advisory committee for Oak Bluffs & Edgartown. Draft MEP report is expected this year; preliminary data has been requested.
